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## Dialogue

- is incremental
- and co-constructed
- even if one person does most of the talking







## Feedback

- backchannels
  - mmm
  - uh-huh
  - nodding
- clarification requests
  - huh?
  - Mary?
  - looking puzzled



## **Telephone conversations**

- are dialogues!
- but with
  - -no non-verbal feedback
  - -more verbal feedback

 many dialogue systems interactions in use today

## **Directory Enquiries**

- extremely restricted domain
- task based
- non-native speakers





## Method

- 14 volunteers
  - -8 male, 6 female
  - -13 non-native English
- operator / caller
  - -2 conversations as each



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#### Data

28 calls
-shortest: 2.31
-longest: 10:46
-3 look-ups per call

- Ack sub-types:
  - -continuer
  - -verbatim
  - -paraphrase
  - -confirm
  - -appreciate
  - $(\kappa = 0.625)$

- turn-type
  - -acknowledge (Ack)
  - -clarification request (CR)  $\rightarrow$  CR sub-types:
  - -clarify (C)
  - $(\kappa = 0.635)$

• content-type

- -general request
- -repeat request
- -confirmation request
- -spelling request
- $(\kappa = 0.689)$
